New Initiatives for 2019-2020 22 Dr. Waite presented a power point titled *New Initiatives* and reviewed with the Board of Trustees 23 the following points: 24 Principal: The district posted a position for a new principal due to the retirement of 25 Principal Nelsen. Eighteen applications were received and seven applicants were 26 interviewed. Dr. Waite reported the pool of applicants was very impressive and a job 27 offer has been extended to one applicant and will be put forth to the Board of Trustees. 28 Staff Shifts: Dr. Waite reported there may be some shifting of staff in the coming year. 29 Certified staff may request a change in grade level or course curriculum. 30 administration is open to changes and consider requests. It was also mentioned that the 31 district hires more certified staff than reimbursed by support units from SDE. 32 Restorative Justice: This program has finished its third year. The district will be 33 evaluating the program this summer and will be looking at "revamping and improving" to 34 meet the original vision of the program. Mr. Sant asked if grant money was available for 35 the program. To Dr. Waite's knowledge there is not. 36 Alternative School: Revamp and Improve- The district has applied to SDE for a 37 competency based learning program (mastery based). If the application is approved, it is 38 possible the district will receive additional funding. This will also change the number of 39 student hours for the program. 40 Middle School: The district has applied for additional grant funds for school 41 improvement through the Title One program. 42 Transportation: The district's transportation department has been researching contracting for transportation services and has asked/published request for letters of intent. The 43 44 district recognizes there are needs within the program that the district is struggling to 45 address. 46 Facilities: The maintenance department has addressed the following projects for the 47 summer-: (1) re-design the library for better access, (2) continue to work on the drainage issues (3) continued improvement to the playground area and covered areas, (4) possible 48 49 purchase of a new lawnmower, (5) continue normal maintenance rotations such as, paint,
