Both individuals are 17 18 traveling. 19 Guest: None 20 21 I. State Testing-Presented by Principals Chapman and Wilkins. Principals Chapman and Wilkins worked together to bring an informative presentation on State / 22 23 Student Testing. Covered topics included: State testing for students that are required include: IRI, WIDA, ISAT, and the SAT. 24 25 Who, What, When: ❖ IRI: Grades kindergarten through third grade. This test is given twice a year 26 27 (September and May) to test students' phonological and reading skills. * WIDA: Testing is kindergarten through twelfth grades for students that qualify as 28 English as a Second Language Student. Testing takes place February through 29 March on English language acquisition and writing. Students can exit the programs 30 31 with a 4.2 assessment score. * ISAT: Grades three to eleven for reading, math, and science. Usually given in 32 33 April and is a participation requirement to graduate. ❖ Idaho Civic Test: Is a graduating requirement but each individual school district is 34 responsible for determining the proficiency level to pass and how the test is given. 35 The Shoshone School District gives the test in Government classes and can be 36 37 taken as many times as needed in order to pass. SAT: Is an assessment test given to juniors in critical thinking, reading, writing, 38 39 and math. This year there were changes to the test such as: testing scores went from 2400 to 1600, multiple choice questions, and is no longer a paper test but a digital 40 41 test. All students must take in order to graduate. . It was noted by the principals that third grade has to take all tests mentioned, with 42 43 the exception of the SAT, and are testing from February to May. 44 Training: ❖ All assessments / tests have staff that are trained to proctor. 45 The principals create a master schedule for testing which include schedules for 46 staff, students, groups, accommodations for students, set testing expectations, and 47 48 protocols. * Testing requires a lot of communication between administrators, teachers, 49 50 secretaries, students, and parents. Board members are invited to attend. The elementary is preparing for the fifth grade camping trip for May 13, 14, and 15. There 30 31 will be a parent information meeting on April 11th.
