RESOLUTION CALLING FOR TRUSTEE ELECTION

Whereas, in accordance with Section 33-503, Idaho Code, as amended, the Board of Trustees of Shoshone Joint School District No. 312 shall cause to be conducted its Trustee Election on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November 2023 (November 7, 2023) for the purpose of electing a trustee for Trustee Zone No. 2, Trustee Zone 3, and Trustee Zone No. 4.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of Shoshone Joint School District No. 312, Lincoln and Jerome Counties, Idaho, as follows:

- Section 1. That a trustee election be and the same is hereby called to be held in Shoshone Joint School District No. 312, Lincoln and Jerome Counties, Idaho on November 7, 2023, for the purpose of electing trustees for zones 2, 3, and 4.
- Section 2. That said election shall be held as specified in Notice of Election, prepared by the County Clerks, in accordance with Section 34 -1406, Idaho Code, as amended.
- Section 3. That said election shall be conducted as other school elections and the persons to conduct said election shall be duly appointed by the County Clerks of Lincoln County and Jerome County.
- Section 4. That the polling places of said election shall be determined by the County Clerks of Lincoln County and Jerome County in accordance with Section 34-1406, Idaho Code, as amended.
- Section 5. That voting at said election shall be by secret and separate ballot, and each ballot shall be prepared by the County Clerks of Lincoln County and Jerome County as required by and in accordance with law.
- Section 6. That immediately following the close of the polls, the Board of County Commissioners shall conduct the canvass of the election results within ten days after the election in the manner prescribed by Title 34, Chapter 12, Idaho Code, as amended. The County Clerk shall then certify the election results to the Clerk of the Board of Trustees. Upon receipt, the Board of Trustees shall subsequently issue the appropriate certificates of election.
- Section 7. The Clerk of the County will also cause the Notice of Election to be published at least two times, the first not less than 12 days before the election date, and the second not less than five days before the election.

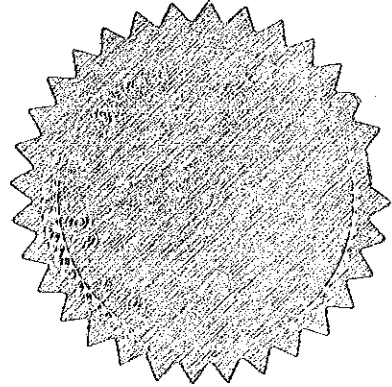

## NOTICE OF SCHOOL TRUSTEE ELECTION

Shoshone Joint School District No. 312  
Lincoln and Jerome Counties, Idaho

Public Notice is hereby given according to law, and the requisite action of the Board of Trustees of Shoshone Joint School District No. 312, Lincoln and Jerome Counties, Idaho, that the school trustee election will be held on the 7th day of November 2023 (Tuesday following the first Monday in November).

Only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 2 may vote for a Zone No. 2 candidate. Only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 3 may vote for a Zone No. 3 candidate. Only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 4 may vote for a Zone No. 4 candidate. The purpose of said election shall be to elect one trustee to serve a period of four (4) years from the date of the election one (1) trustee who resides within Trustee Zone No. 2, one (1) trustee who resides within Trustee Zone No. 3, and one (1) trustee who resides within Trustee Zone No. 4.

Trustee Zones No. 2, 3, and No. 4 are more specifically described as follows:

### TRUSTEE ZONE 2

**BEGINNING** at the U.S. Highway 93 and South School District Boundary and the Lincoln-Jerome County Line, thence

Northerly along State Highway 93 approximately 5.5 miles to the South Shoshone City Limits Line, thence

Easterly along Shoshone City Limits approximately 890 feet, thence

Northerly along Shoshone City Limits approximately 350 feet along Shoshone City Limits to State Highway 24 (Dietrich Highway) and Beverly Street, thence

Northeasterly along Beverly Street to Rail Street East, thence

Northwesterly along Rail Street East to Greenwood Street (State Highway 75), thence

Northeasterly along Greenwood Street (State Highway 75) to right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River, thence

Southeasterly along right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River to Beverly Street, thence

Northerly along Beverly Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to Cherry Street, thence

Northerly along Cherry Street to 4<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Elm Street, thence

Northwesterly along Elm Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Grape Street, thence

Southerly along Grape Street to right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River, thence

Southwesterly along right bank of the Little Wood River approximately 260 feet to west Shoshone City Limits, thence

Southwesterly along Shoshone City Limits approximately 540 feet to U.S. Highway 26, thence

Westerly along U.S. Highway 26 approximately 4.1 miles to the School District Boundary being on the East line of Section 36, Township 5 South, Range 16 East, B.M., thence

Southerly then Westerly along School District Boundary to US Highway 26, thence leaving the School District Boundary

Southwesterly along US Highway 26 to West School District Boundary, thence

Southerly then Easterly along School District Boundary to State Highway 93 and the Lincoln-Jerome County Line being the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

### **TRUSTEE ZONE 3**

**BEGINNING** at the intersection of Dorothy Street and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to Cherry Street, thence

Northwesterly along Cherry Street to 4<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Elm Street, thence

Northerly along Elm Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Grape Street, thence

Southerly along Grape Street to right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River, thence

Southwesterly along right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River approximately 260 feet to west Shoshone City Limits, thence

Northerly, then Easterly, then Southerly, then Easterly following Shoshone City Limits Line to State Highway 75, thence leaving said City Limits Line

Southwesterly along State Highway 75 (Greenwood Street) approximately 165 feet to 6<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Easterly along 6<sup>th</sup> Street to Dorothy Street, thence

Southerly along Dorothy Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

**BEGINNING** at the intersection of Unnamed Two-Track and the East School District Boundary approximately 300 feet north of the Southeast corner, of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 18 East, Boise Meridian, thence

Westerly approximately 700 feet to the Big Wood River, thence

Southerly then Westerly along Big Wood River to State Highway 75, thence

Northerly then Northeasterly along State Highway 75 to the North School District Boundary, thence

Easterly then Southerly along said School District Boundary to said Unnamed Two-Track and the East School District Boundary being approximately 300 feet north of the Southeast corner, of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 18 East, Boise Meridian and to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

As provided by Idaho Code, Section 34-1407 no write-in vote shall be counted unless a declaration of intent has been timely filed with the Clerk of the Board of Trustees indicating that the person desired the office and is legally qualified to assume the duties of school trustee if duly elected. The candidate must also provide to the Clerk the signatures of five electors of the candidate's specific zone on a paper nominating petition as provided in section 34-1404, Idaho Code. The candidate's declaration of intent shall be filed not later than 45 days before the day of the elections. The polls will be opened as prescribed by the County Clerk at the following locations as pursuant to and in accordance with Title 34 Idaho Code (to be determined and published by the County Clerk). LIST OF POLLING PLACES AND ADDRESS: (to be determined and published by the County Clerk). An elector must be a registered voter who has resided in this state and in this school district at least thirty (30) days preceding the election.

The application for a mail-in absentee ballot must be received by the Lincoln County Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m. on the eleventh day before the election. It must be received on a form made available at the Lincoln County Elections Office, 111 West B, Shoshone, Idaho on Monday through Friday. Such absentee ballots must be returned by 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election.

An application for in-person absentee voting at the absent elector's polling place must be received by the Lincoln County Clerk not later than 5:00 p.m. on the Friday before the election. It must be received on a form made available at the Lincoln County Elections Office, 111 West B, Shoshone, Idaho on Monday through Friday. Such absentee ballots must be returned by 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election.

Official notice of the School Trustee Election will be posted by the Lincoln County and Jerome County Clerk's Office.

Public Notice is hereby given according to law, and the requisite action of the Board of Trustees of Shoshone Joint School District No. 312, Lincoln and Jerome Counties, Idaho, that the School Trustee Election will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023, the Tuesday following the first Monday in November.

Notice is also provided that:

Candidates interested in filing a Declaration of Candidacy must file not later than 5:00 p.m. on September 8, 2023 (the ninth Friday preceding the election for which the nomination is made).

Each Declaration must bear the name of the candidate, state the term for which declaration of candidacy is made, and bear the signature of not less than five qualified School District electors of the Trustee Zones of which the candidate is resident.

Only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 2 may declare candidacy for Zone No. 2 trustee position. Only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 3 may declare candidacy for Zone No. 3 trustee position. Only those qualified electors residing in Trustee Zone No. 4 may declare candidacy for Zone No. 4 trustee position. The purpose of said election shall be to elect trustees to serve for a period of four (4) years, specifically, one trustee who resides within Trustee Zone No. 2, one trustee who resides within Trustee Zone No. 3, one trustee who resides within Trustee Zone No. 4.

A Declaration of Candidacy must be filed with the Clerk of the Shoshone Joint School District No. 312 who will then file it with the Lincoln County Clerk's office between the dates set forth above. Each Declaration of Candidacy must bear the name of the candidate, state the term for which Declaration of Candidacy is made, and bear the signature of not less than five (5) qualified school district electors of the trustee zone of which the candidate is resident.

Trustee Zone 2 is described as follows:

**BEGINNING** at the U.S. Highway 93 and South School District Boundary and the Lincoln-Jerome County Line, thence

Northerly along State Highway 93 approximately 5.5 miles to the South Shoshone City Limits Line, thence

Easterly along Shoshone City Limits approximately 890 feet, thence

Northerly along Shoshone City Limits approximately 350 feet along Shoshone City Limits to State Highway 24 (Dietrich Highway) and Beverly Street, thence

Northeasterly along Beverly Street to Rail Street East, thence

Northwesterly along Rail Street East to Greenwood Street (State Highway 75), thence

Northeasterly along Greenwood Street (State Highway 75) to right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River, thence

Southeasterly along right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River to Beverly Street, thence

Northerly along Beverly Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to Cherry Street, thence

Northerly along Cherry Street to 4<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Elm Street, thence

Northwesterly along Elm Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Grape Street, thence

Southerly along Grape Street to right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River, thence

Southwesterly along right bank of the Little Wood River approximately 260 feet to west Shoshone City Limits, thence

Southwesterly along Shoshone City Limits approximately 540 feet to U.S. Highway 26, thence

Westerly along U.S. Highway 26 approximately 4.1 miles to the School District Boundary being on the East line of Section 36, Township 5 South, Range 16 East, B.M., thence

Southerly then Westerly along School District Boundary to US Highway 26, thence leaving the School District Boundary

Southwesterly along US Highway 26 to West School District Boundary, thence

Southerly then Easterly along School District Boundary to State Highway 93 and the Lincoln-Jerome County Line being the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Trustee Zone 3 is described as follows:

**BEGINNING** at the intersection of Dorothy Street and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, thence



Westerly along 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to Cherry Street, thence

Northwesterly along Cherry Street to 4<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 4<sup>th</sup> Street to Elm Street, thence

Northerly along Elm Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Westerly along 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Grape Street, thence

Southerly along Grape Street to right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River, thence

Southwesterly along right (Northerly) bank of the Little Wood River approximately 260 feet to west Shoshone City Limits, thence

Northerly, then Easterly, then Southerly, then Easterly following Shoshone City Limits Line to State Highway 75, thence leaving said City Limits Line

Southwesterly along State Highway 75 (Greenwood Street) approximately 165 feet to 6<sup>th</sup> Street, thence

Easterly along 6<sup>th</sup> Street to Dorothy Street, thence

Southerly along Dorothy Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Trustee Zone 4 is described as follows:

**BEGINNING** at the intersection of Unnamed Two-Track and the East School District Boundary approximately 300 feet north of the Southeast corner, of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 18 East, Boise Meridian, thence

Westerly approximately 700 feet to the Big Wood River, thence


Southerly then Westerly along Big Wood River to State Highway 75, thence

Northerly then Northeasterly along State Highway 75 to the North School District Boundary, thence

Easterly then Southerly along said School District Boundary to said Unnamed Two-Track and the East School District Boundary being approximately 300 feet north of the Southeast corner, of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 18 East, Boise Meridian and to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

As provided by Idaho Code, Section 34-1407, no write-in vote shall be counted unless a Declaration of Intent has been filed with the Clerk of the Shoshone Joint School District No. 312 who will then file it with the Lincoln County Clerk's office indicating that the person desires the office is legally qualified to assume the duties of school trustee if elected. The Declaration of Intent shall be filed not later September 15, 2023.
