

A staff member of Shoshone School District has tested positive for COVID. The staff member does not have regular contact with students, has been working from home and is mostly asymptomatic. Contact tracing has been done. It has been determined that no student or employee is a close contact.

Our school district follows Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Department of Health guidelines for the management of individuals who have been diagnosed with, or exposed to, COVID-19. Our school district follows these strict guidelines to protect the safety of our students, families, and staff. The employee will work from home until protocols allow a return.

While no students or staff have been determined to be close contact and no one is recommended to self-quarantine, it is still important to watch for symptoms. Contact your child's medical provider for guidance if your child develops any of the COVID-19 symptoms. Common symptoms include fever, cough, and shortness of breath, diarrhea, abdominal pain, and loss of smell or taste.
