Child Find Screening for 3–5–year-olds

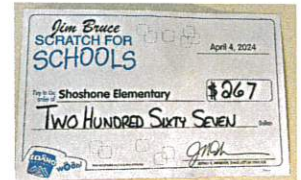

I.S.A.T. Testing for Grades 3–5

ISAT testing for grades 3-5 is scheduled to begin at 8:15 a.m. on April 9, 10, 16, 17. Fifth grade students will have an additional science test on April 23. Students will test on their math, reading and language skills. Fifth grade students will have one additional test for science on May 2. Each test takes approximately 2 hours to complete. ISAT testing is very important so please help your child do the best they can by getting them to bed early on testing nights. If they do not eat breakfast at school please feed them a good breakfast at home, and please make any appointments for them after school.
