Inspection of Instructional Materials

A student’s parent(s)/guardian(s) may, within a reasonable time of the request, inspect any instructional material used as part of their child’s educational curriculum.

The term “instructional material,” for purposes of this policy, means instructional content that is provided to a student, regardless of its format, printed or representational materials, audio-visual materials, and materials in electronic or digital formats (such as materials accessible through the Internet). The term does not include academic tests or academic assessments.

Inspection of Assessment Materials

Parents who wish to examine any assessment materials may do so by contacting the Principal. Parental approval is necessary before administering an individual intelligence test or a diagnostic personality test.
