#### Immunization of Students

The State of Idaho and the Shoshone School District Board of Trustees require that all students entering school for the first time must show a valid record of their immunization status. The following immunizations are required:

##### Diphtheria-Pertussis-Tetanus (DPT)

School entry requires four (4) doses [However, to be medically complete, a child usually needs 5 DPT]

##### Oral Polio Virus (OPV)

School entry requires three (3) doses [However, to be medically complete, a child usually needs 4 OPV]

##### Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR)

School entry requires one (1) dose. [However, to be medically complete, a child usually needs 2 MMR]

##### Hepatitis B (Hep B)

Children born after November 22, 1991 are required to have three (3) Hep B.

A parent or legal guardian must present to school officials the immunization information or a signed certificate of exemption. The law allows the following exemptions:

1. Medical – must be signed by a licensed physician.
2. Religious beliefs – signed by parent or legal guardian.
3. Personal reasons – signed by parent or legal guardian.
