EXTENDED ABSENCES- If you have vacation or holiday time scheduled that will consist of 3 or more days, an Extended Absence Form *must* be completed before your student takes their leave from school. We have forms in the front office. If you have any concerns about your child, please give us a call at 208-886-2381.

HEALTH OFFICE NEWS- A child showing any indications of being ill *before* leaving for school should be kept at home. Parents/guardians will be asked to take their child home whenever their child displays any of the following symptoms: temp over 100 degrees, vomiting, diarrhea, pink eye, suspicious skin rash/lesions, live head lice, any other signs of illness per the school's discretion. Before returning to school, students need to be fever-free for 24 hours, without a fever reducing medication, free of vomiting and diarrhea for 24 hours. If on medication for a contagious condition, such as strep throat, they must be on antibiotics for 12 hours before returning to school or per doctors recommendations. If a student is absent for 5 consecutive days due to illness a Physician note may be requested. If you have any concerns about your child, please give us a call at 208-886-2381.
