IDAHO READING INDICATOR (I.R.I.)

All Kindergarten through third grade students in the state of Idaho is required to take a reading test in the fall. The test is known as the Idaho Reading Indicator (IRI). The Fall (IRI) is an individual 30-minute test that will be given to your child starting September 1, 2026. The scoring is done on a 1 - 3 scale. A one indicates the student is at grade level, a two is near grade level, and a three indicates the student is significantly below grade level. Students who receive a 2 or 3 are eligible for extra reading help.

MESSAGES TO YOUR CHILD
